The purpose of the Junior Keeper Academy and Keeper Academy run by Lakeland Wildlife Oasis is to have fun, experience new opportunities and learn new skills in a supportive environment.

- We aim to create an open & honest atmosphere, where everyone feels safe and supported. We expect all staff and volunteers to behave in a responsible, caring and supportive manner, respecting colleagues, academy participants and our animals. In turn we expect all academy participants to positively participate in the activities and to respect each other, the staff, volunteers and animals
- We expect everyone to commit themselves to provide an atmosphere free from discrimination (on the grounds of race, gender, marital status, ethnic origin, sexual orientation, physical ability, educational attainment or wealth etc.) and bullying (whether physical, verbal or any other form)
- In order to keep staff, volunteers, academy participants and animals safe we have taken the decision to ask participants NOT to bring electronic items (including MP3 players and mobile phones etc.) on site with them as they act as a distraction. There is also the danger that these will get broken or lost and Lakeland Wildlife Oasis will not take responsibility if this happens. Items of this nature should be left with parents/guardians during the session.

If staff or volunteers feel that your behaviour is inappropriate, first of all a member of staff will take you aside to have a 'quiet word', where you will be given the chance to discuss the situation.

If this is necessary twice during the activity, or in the unlikely event of a more serious incident (e.g. physical violence, bullying, constant verbal abuse towards other participants or staff/volunteers), you will immediately be removed from the situation and your parents will be contacted to pick you up. A meeting will then be set up to include: yourself, your parent/carer and a staff member, to discuss future attendance.
